- 08.00 Start
- 08.15 Last minute registration. Payment of last minute registrations.
- 16.00 End of finishing time. Turning in measuring tools, reporting catch and copying memory cards.
- 19.00 Seminar. Vägga high school in Karlshamn. Lottery in the program pause.

- 07.00 Start. Distribution of measuring tools at the respective starting point..
- 15.00 End of finishing time. Turning in measuring tools, reporting catch and copying memory cards.
- 17.30 Price ceremony at Fiskeshopen in Karlshamn.

## **IMPORTANT!**

Catch report must be turned in after each day. This is to ensure that everybody is safe at shore. Measuring tool will be returned after the tournament day 2.

**The starting badge must be on the starting table before the end of fishing time is over for the day.**

*This to ensure that all are safely returned from fishing. If you are late, don't forget to call and report to the tournament staff. Otherwise you will be personally responsible for any cost connected to an eventual rescue action. This is for your own safety!*

Catch registration:

Catch report is to be turned in after each day. Pictures of registered fish to be copied from digital camera memory cards at the finishing point. See below about accepted memory cards. The pictures are to be used to verify the length of reported fish.

**Fish to be kept must be between 40-75cm according to Swedish laws. It is strongly recommended to release all fish during the competition.**

Camera/memory card:

Each participant uses his/her own digital camera. The camera has to have a memory card of one of the following types: CF, MS, MS PRO, MS pro duo, M2, MMC, SD, SD HC, MicroSD, TF, XD. Transfer of pictures directly from camera is not accepted!

Methods allowed:

Spinning/casting, natural bait and flyfishing. All methods are limited to one rod per person. No division into classes - all participants compete in the same category. The longest pike wins.

- Catch limit: Only one fish - the longest fish per day and participant - is counted in the competition. Fish have to be 60 cm's minimum length to be counted into the competition.
- Boat/ belly boat/wading: Minimum two fishermen per boat. Belly boat fishing is allowed on a solitary basis. Floating aid is strongly recommend at fishing from boat/belly boat or when wading.
- Equipment: Participants will be given a starting tag and catch report each day. These are to be returned at the end of the day.
- Day 1 is the measuring sticks given to the participants. These are returned after the tournament day 2.

### **IMPORTANT!**

In the evening of the first day of the competition, a seminar on the coastal pike population is held. A presence lottery with prizes will be held among the present fishermen. Prizes must be collected personally.

- Security note: Be careful with security and security equipment. You are fishing at your own risk!

- Profit/taxation: All prizes must be collected personally. Eventual tax on prize values are payed by the participant himself.

### **Restricted areas:**

- Skräbeån: All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31
- Östra Orlundsån: All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31, inside of a line drawn 500 meters from the center between the two outer points of the mouth.
- Mörrumsån: All fishing in area A forbidden.
- Bräkneån: All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31 inside of the line between the south point of Klockenabben, the south point of Rangsö, and Väbynäs.
- Ronnebyån: All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31, inside of a line from the east point of the Droppemåla peninsula, going in a straight easterly direction to the mainland at Aspan.
- Lyckebyån: All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31, Inside of straight lines

drawn from the part of the Gullberna point that is closest to the island Mörtelkläppen, to Mörtelkläppen's northern point and from there on to the point on Ringö that is west of the Ringö cove.

Listerbyån:

All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31, inside of a line from the recreational harbour in Slättanäs, to the point of Blötö.

Silletorpsån:

All fishing forbidden sept 15 – dec 31, inside of a line drawn from the outer part of the pier at Strömshall to the southernmost part of the navy pier at the Rosenholm works.
